

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: Can I get a job when the school - course is over?

Answer: We have contracted universities. And with our contracted universities, you can transfer directly after completing level 6 without TOEFL exam. After the universities, America gives you the right to a one-year internship.

Q2: Will the students coming to your school have a work permit?

Answer: A student visa holder has the right to work at school for a maximum of 20 hours per week. To do this, there must first be a vacancy for you, you must apply for the job and then be accepted. Other than that, a student visa does not have a legal work permit.

Q3: Are there students from other countries? If so, from which countries do these students come? Are there Turkish students as well?

Answer: Currently, the majority of our students are Brazilian students. We also have students from Asian countries such as Korea, Japan, China and Europe. We also receive requests from Turkey, but this is a school that has been running for 20 years and has already educated more than 6000 students from 50 different countries. Since Just English is already a functioning course, this is the current student intake.

Q4: On which days are the classes and is attendance compulsory?

Answer: The classes are as follows; Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday. You have to take 18 hours of classes per week. Since the type of visa you will apply for will be a student visa, you have to take 18 hours of classes per week and your attendance requirement is 80 percent.

Q5: How much are the school fees?

Answer: Language school prices in East Coast are one of the most frequently asked questions. Currently, a language school charges around 1000 dollars and above for a month. Just English's prices are below this average, it is not possible to say an exact price right now. The price of a 3-month enrolled student is not the same as a 6-month enrolled student, or if you enroll for 1 year, the price decreases according to how long the time is.. If you are already registered or enrolled in Just English in Turkey, you can get gift courses in the US after purchasing a certain course there. Also, since we already have a Turkish-speaking team, you don't need to come with any mediators or agencies. You will have a great advantage that way too.

Q6: Will I lose my money if I don't get a visa?

Answer: Regarding the school fee, first of all, of course, you will be asked for certain documents when you register. We have cash or installment options. Apart from that, there is a SEVIS fee that you pay to the US government for each student. There is also a fee you pay at the American Consulate for the visa.

Q7: What is Long Branch like? What's close by, what's around? How is transportation?

Answer: Long Branch is a small coastal city in the United States. With 30,000 inhabitants, it is a small town, very quiet, free from danger, etc. It is famous for its beach, and our students at school can always get there quickly (weekdays, weekends), even during lunch breaks. It is also famous for the fact that 7 American presidents lived here. In fact, there is a special region called 7 Presidents and one inland, many of them preferred this place and both lived here and spent their vacations here in certain summers, it is also known as the city of their presidents. Some of them have lived here for many years, some of them have spent their summers here, even though they have not spent their lives here for many years. We have a very good friendship with the mayor of the city, thanks to him, we always take our students and he always tells them about Long Branch and its history, he also comes to our school events, he is the brother of the congressman here, one of the brothers is a congressman and other one is the mayor. They don't really talk about each other like we do, you know, my brother is like this and that, and there is nothing like that here, I never hear about each other, but I know them, I mean, we meet and I see them separately. Yes, let's talk a little bit about the impact of the weekday pandemic today, New Jersey and New York are where we are close to. It has now become one of the safest places in America. Of course, it is very interesting because friends who have followed it for a while were in the worst situation, the numbers were very high, 25-30 percent of those who were tested had covid. That number has dropped to one percent, and the two states that were least affected and safest in the pandemic in the United States are New York and New Jersey, and I mention them together because we are one hour away from New York in terms of distance, very close, so people here are always connected to each other like working in New Jersey and going to New York, or working in New York and going to New Jersey. There is such a tiki bar here, it belongs to the hotel but it is open to the public, anyone can visit. They are considered together with such a concept called a tri-state, they act together in laws and so on, and mayors, governors and so on, and this is what happened in the pandemic. Now, when we think about where we are from here and how far we are, we are exactly one hour away from the city, the center of New York, Times Square. We are 34 miles away, about an hour's drive from here, there is a very large train station just five minutes away from the school, and there are commutes to and from the city from that station. When I say big, I'm not talking about physically, I'm talking about the train structure, so one of the main lines passes through and you can be in Times Square in Manhattan within an hour. Yes, friends, we are in Long Branch Beach again, for those who do not know, I am pinning it immediately.

Q8: We know that there are different standards of living at different prices all over the US, where does New Jersey or Long Branch fall into this category? Are there a lot of high taxes? What are the accommodation rates like? Do people need to have a lot of money there?

Answer: The issues of cheap places, expensive places, close to the city, and far from the city vary a lot. Our other school in Los Angeles is very central and right in the center of Los Angeles. But Long Branch is not very central. So the cost of living and prices here are below average. I mean, New Jersey can actually be considered to be at an above-average expensive level in America, but Long Branch is not like that. As I said, this place is like a small town, maybe we are in one of the most vibrant areas right now. Because it is summer, it is very active here, and in winter, of course, there are much fewer people here. There are also people who normally live in New York and spend their summers here. To answer the question specifically; it is possible to find a house and live in the Long Branch neighborhood where we are located. So what does that mean? Let's take a room for example. When a student needs to find a room, they can do it for 600 - 700 dollars. In the city centers, in New York, this can be around 800 - 1000 dollars, but here, you know, for 500, 600, 700 dollars, a student can find a comfortable room where he will not hesitate to live. We are sometimes asked here, you know that. Normally, we do not provide any assistance for accommodation in accordance with the law. But of course, we always support our students to live here, but this is in the form of support, we do not have such a structure and we do not have any program where we provide a service where they can live. But that is also part of our programs and our vision for the future. Maybe we hope to do it in a year or two. There are bars around the beaches here. In restaurants, they still can't serve inside, they put tables and chairs outside, and New Jersey is now in the fourth phase. It is not yet back to normal to go inside the restaurants and sit down. it is not possible right now.

Q9: How are the course prices? Can you tell me about the prices?

Answer: It is very enjoyable to answer this question. Because we, as an institution that is newly structured in the US, that wants to be in many states in the US and wants to move forward rapidly in this sector, you know that people are following us, we have 20 schools in Turkey. We definitely set out with the best service, the best education in a very reasonable way. I can say that we are really competitive in that regard. I like to talk about this because there are schools in New Jersey that charge a thousand dollars a month, for example, over a thousand dollars and up to 2 thousand dollars. But our current monthly average varies depending on how many hours of classes you take, how many days a week you are there. But on average, I can say that we have a monthly cost of 440 - 560 dollars for a student who takes 18-20 hours of classes. This is really an economical price that is much lower than the average, both in the US and in New York, and while doing this, we are not lacking in education in any way. Our American teachers are also very competent and have many years of experience and we are at the beginning of this journey with our Tesol certified teachers. We are new here and we are doing our best to provide the best service in a much more economical way.

Q10: How do we apply for a student visa?

Answer: You need to apply to any of the Just English institutions to get the document called I20, which is required to get a student visa. What is required to get it? Which documents do you need to bring? You need to document to the bank that you have this amount of money saved. As Just English Institution, we inform the students that they need to bring these documents first. Students bring those documents and then when we approve them, an I20 is issued to them. With this I20, they go to the American consulates and apply to us, and if their visa is approved, they come here with an F1 visa with the I20

Q11: Do we need to be a university student?

Answer: No, you do not have to be a university student. Of course, there are a few important nuances here about whether the American Consulate will grant the visa or not. One of them is to show the situation with a certain amount of money in the bank we mentioned. All of these factors can be taken as a whole factor, we cannot say that you cannot get it in this way. Because this is something that depends entirely on the authority of the employees of the American Consulate at that moment. Any institution cannot say why you did not give them why you did not give them why you did that. But Just English allows you to go through the filter. While you are already making the applications and preparing the documents, if you have a deficiency, a remarkable mistake, Just English has already passed it through that filter with you. Therefore, after Just English says that it is okay to apply in this way, you can at least go to the consulate with a little more peace of mind.

Q12.: Can an F1 visa holder take his/her spouse and children to the US?

Answer: He/she can take them with him/her. The spouse and children are also given a visa called F2. A student can bring his spouse and children to America with that visa. Yes, friends, we only have the right to five children, and this is a protocol.

Q13: How are the social activities at Just English New Jersey campus?

Answer: Social activities are a step ahead of other schools in Turkey where we always want to stand out and act in a way that we learn while having fun. Since we were founded, all the special days of America, whether it's Halloween or Christmas, are already celebrated in our school. But apart from that, we also throw special parties. We are constantly organizing an event both inside and outside the school. Some of these are also called lectures, such as a city tour to Manhattan, a city tour to Washington D.C. There are programs that you plan as both entertainment and learning that include both New Jersey and New York state in the Long Branch region in this region. Here, like a normal class, if a student has a class at a certain time in the morning, say between 8 and 10 o'clock, they can visit a library with their teacher, or visit the mayor, or go and

visit restaurants in Manhattan. For example, we had a very nice program where a teacher showed us around hotels. How to work in hotels, what is the working system of hotels, where people from all over the world come to this region, etc. We also organize such sectoral activities related to hotel management. We help them learn English by using it. It is very valuable for students to get out of school and socialize a little more. Students like these programs very much. We actually have such a program all the time. And we have really increased the number of students since we started.

Q14. Do you offer housing in Los Angeles?

Answer: We do not offer housing or host family services. Students typically wait until they arrive in Los Angeles to find roommates or a place to rent.
