Definitions



- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are
 called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing
 employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary
 institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

The institutional charges (tuition) refund is exclusively based on the money received by JE-Los Angeles after all other applicable fees owed to JE-Los Angeles are deducted. Any money not paid, discounts or promotions will be void and will not apply upon withdrawal. The tuition charge will be based on the standard published price.

Students will be refunded 100% of the amount paid for tuition (institutional charges), less any non-refundable fees not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Fees paid to USCIS are 100% non-refundable.

If after the above cancellation deadline, the refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro rata refund, less any non-refundable fee and the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) fee. Pro rata refund calculation: the amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, divided by the number of days or hours in the program), multiplied by the number of days student attended, or was scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal.

Under California law, if the student withdraws after using more than 60% of the class hours paid for, no refund will be issued.

If JE-Los Angeles cancels a program after a student's enrollment, all fees will be refunded. Upon cancellation, withdrawal, termination or completion of enrollment, any refund due to the student will be determined and will be paid within 45 days after the date of determination.
